

The Waupaca Area Model Railroad Club is a diverse and talented, engendering great comradeship, with a goal to promote and introduce Model Railroading to the general public. New members are always welcome. Our primary activities include:

- Thursday evening sessions:
 - These weekly sessions are at club member's layouts. Activities include model building, track laying, landscaping, benchwork, wiring, programming or operating trains. Each layout is unique and is an opportunity to learn and teach others.
 - About one to two Thursdays per month a member hosts an operating session where members can operate on someone else's layout.
- About five to seven times per year we travel to other train shows both in state and outside the state of Wisconsin to display our 52'x 22' HO scale portable layout and help promote our hobby in the area. Many times this is a fundraiser for that organization hosting the show. By becoming a member, you will be able to attend these shows for free and run your trains on the portable layout.
- We have two fundraisers annually...
 - Strawberry Fest Swap Meet the third Saturday in June.
 - o Iola Car Chow, usually the second weekend in July.

Volunteering at our own Strawberry Fest Swap Meet, and the Iola Car Show are our annual fundraisers. These two activities allow us to maintain a low dues structure, maintain our portable layout, and pay for special activities including funds for out of state train shows. These fundraisers also help us give back to the community by donating to the historic Wapaca depot, the Christmas Food Pantry and help fund the scholarship program. Other activities that support the well-being of the club include hosting/maintaining the club website and the traveling train layouts (Thomas and HO).

Our club is unique because members are willing to contribute their skills and assist others in learning and/ or refining their skills. All members are welcome to take part in these activities.
